## CHAPTER 50: GARBAGE

### Section

#### **' 50.01 SCHEDULES.**

The town refuse and garbage collection system shall collect refuse and garbage on a weekly basis. The time schedules for collection shall be as set by the Board of Aldermen from time to time.  
(1989 Code, ' 8-46)

#### **' 50.02 CONTAINERS REQUIRED; PLACEMENT FOR COLLECTION.**

(A) Every person owning or occupying premises, upon which refuse or garbage of any kind may accumulate, shall provide and keep on hand a sufficient number of metal or plastic garbage cans or receptacles of adequate size and height, not to exceed 35-gallons= capacity per receptacle, to adequately accommodate and receive all refuse or garbage which shall collect upon his or her premises.

(B) Each person shall maintain the cans or receptacles at some suitable place upon his or her lot that will be readily accessible to the refuse and garbage collection employees of the town.  
(1989 Code, ' 8-47) Penalty, see ' 10.99

#### **' 50.03 ITEMS NOT TO BE COLLECTED; VOLUME ALLOWED.**

(A) Large limbs, stumps, construction debris, materials from store openings and other bulky items shall not be picked up by the town refuse and garbage collection system.

(B) The amount of refuse and garbage that a customer may deposit for collection in a single week shall be limited to 5 containers.

**50.04 PLACEMENT AND REMOVAL OF RECEPTACLES.**

Any resident (owner or renter) who places his or her receptacle curbside more than 24 hours before schedule pickup or that a resident (owner or renter) who fails to remove from curbside to the rear of their residence belonging to him or her any garbage receptacle within 24 hours after garbage pickup shall constitute a misdemeanor, subject to the following:

First offense	A written warning
Second offense	\$50 fine
